DIRECTIONS FOR STUDENT APPLICATION FOR INDUCTION:

- 1.) Go to www.nhsda-ndeo.org and click on Find Your Chapter
- 2.) Click the Find Your Chapter button.
- 3.) Search for a chapter by Chapter Name, City and State, or using the interactive map.
- 4.) Select the appropriate chapter and click on the **Apply** button. (Note that both Junior and Secondary Chapters will appear on this page, if the school hosts chapters in both programs. Students should be sure that they are applying to the appropriate chapter for their grade level.)
- 5.) Fill out the application form with contact information and grade level, and create a username and password for the site. (The username and password will be used to make changes to their application on the rare occasion that they will be needed.) Click on the **Apply** button when finished. You are done with the online portion.
- 6.) Print the paper application (point tracker) on the next page. Use the point system sheet on page 3 to fill out the application point tracker. Once completed, turn in the paper application to the QC welcome desk between April 1st and May 1st. All activities track **MUST BE** from the 2017-2018 school year.
- 7.) Print off a transcript that includes the entire 2017-2018 school year up until your turn in date (i.e. you cannot only submit trimester 2. You would need to submit a transcript that includes trimester 1 and 2 assuming that trimester 3 has not been completed yet). Turn in the transcript to the welcome desk with your paper point tracker application.



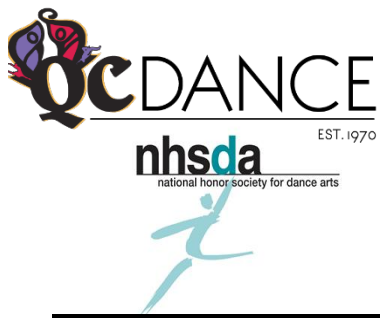

2017-2018 National Induction Point System

Any combination of points can be used, but you must have points from each category. Members are responsible for tracking their own points using the “NHSDA Tracking Sheet” and will be expected to show proof of points achieved by **May 1st, 2018.***
